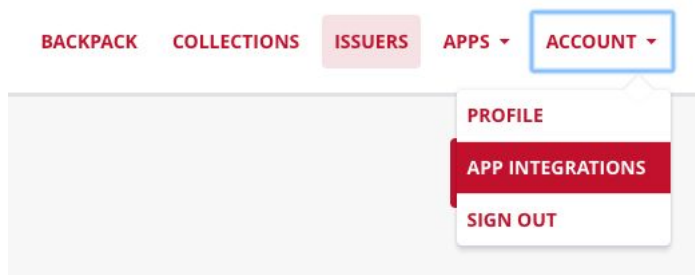




How Do I Create a Badgr Account?

1. Go to www.badgr.com and click [Create an Account](#)
2. Use the same email (maybe password) as you do for your Canvas account
3. Once you create your account, go to “Account” / “App Integrations” to get the necessary info to activate Badgr in your Canvas Instance



How Do I Add the Badgr LTI to My Canvas Course?



1. Go to the course
2. Click Settings from the Course Menu
3. Choose the Apps tab from the top
4. Search for “Badgr”
5. Click the [+ Add App](#) button
6. Enter the consumer key and shared secret from badr.com account

How Do I Become (or Make Someone) An Issuer?

Back-end Canvas Administrator Tip...

1. Click the **ISSUERS** tab
2. Click **CREATE ISSUER**
3. Enter the following:
 - a. **Issuer Name** – e.g., "North Ridge High School English Department"
 - b. **Website URL** – e.g., "http://northridge.mydistrict.k12.us"
 - c. **Contact Email** – e.g., "english@northridge.mydistrict.k12.us"
 - d. **Issuer Description** – e.g., "The instructors of the English Department at the nationally recognized North Ridge School"
4. Upload an issuer image
5. Click **ADD ISSUER** to save



Option 1: Create A Badge in Badgr (Instance Level)

Badges can be made in the Badgr “Backpack”

1. Go to Backpack
2. Click Add Badge
3. Upload an image and complete



Option 2: Create A Badge in a Canvas Course (Teacher Level)

Badges can also be created directly from the “Badges” link on your course menu


1. Click on Badges in Course Menu
2. Click the drop down arrow next to your name in the list of issuers
3. Choose “Create New Badge” and complete the form

The new badge form in the Canvas course is a little different than on the Badgr.com website, but it contains the same information.



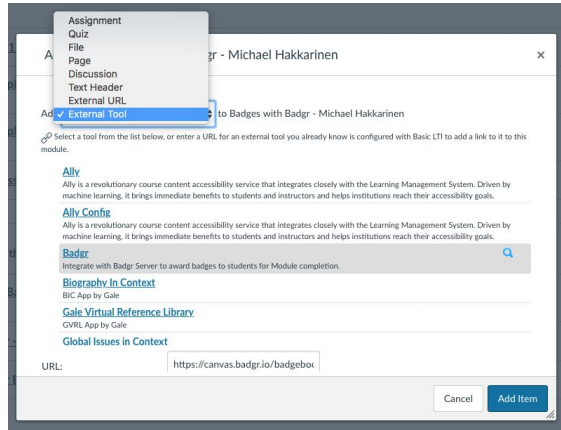
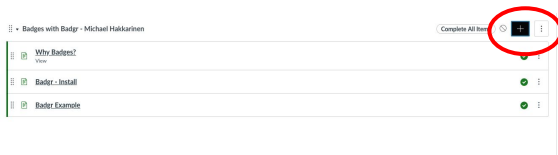

How Do I Award A Badge with Badgr?



Automatically...

1. Add the Badge to a Module
2. Click the “+” button for that module
3. Select “External Tool” and choose Badgr
4. Add the badge to the module
5. Select the badge and select “Show Evidence”
6. Determine the URL students need to submit



How Do I Award A Badge with Badgr?



Manually



1. Go to www.badgr.com and log in
2. Select the “Issuers” tab
3. Click on the “Award” button in line with the badge you would like to award
4. Add the email address of anyone who you would like to award that badge
